Job Description

Instructional Assistants (IA) work with Faculty to manage the delivery of the course. This can include helping to prepare materials, set-up and clean-up of classrooms, canvas management, tracking attendance, or other responsibilities based on the needs of Faculty. IA's must be available for scheduled class times for the entire duration of the course. Faculty may also offer additional work outside of those times, up to the maximum hours allowed.

The IAs will be responsible for attending and supporting both classes as well as after-class responsibilities including some grading. Experience with Generative AI tools, especially image and video tools, is beneficial, but not required.

Scheduled Times

Classes will start on May 14, 2026, and end on August 6, 2026. Classes take place on Thursdays from 4:00-7:00 pm. The Instructional Assistant must be available during these times.

Responsibilities

Responsibilities are varied and will reflect the needs of the instructor. Responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Canvas management: Upload content into modules, create reminders for upcoming assignments, troubleshoot student issues, organize and track student materials /assignment submissions.
- Assist in grading of assignments.
- Check in with students to ensure there are no areas of confusion.
- Track attendance.

Because responsibilities range widely, instructional assistants should meet with the instructor upon receiving their assignment to establish a clear understanding of job expectations.
